Harmony Day at Balgownie Public School

Mongolian Throat Singing - Wear Something Orange

Harmony Day is a celebration of our cultural diversity - a day of cultural respect for everyone who calls Australia home. To celebrate this in our school, we are asking <u>all</u> <u>students to wear something orange to school on Friday 20th March.</u>



To further celebrate Harmony Day, Balgownie Public School students will be participating in an interactive performance of **Mongolian Throat Singing**.

In Mongolia, throat singing is an ancient art form whereby the singer uses the voice to create anywhere from two to four notes at the same time generating a sound that appears to be several voices at once! Throat singing is said to have developed centuries ago by nomads in a region called Tuva, an independent republic between Mongolia and Siberia. The practice is said to have originated in a contest between rural herdsmen to see how far they could get their voices to carry through valleys.

The session includes:

- A live throat singing & Mongolian horse fiddle performance
- A traditional Mongolian throat singing workshop for students
- A final showcase performance of what has been learnt

There is no cost to students.
