FROM THE PRINCIPAL'S DESK

Dear Parents and Carers.

COVID -19 update – As you may have seen in the note sent home on Tuesday, or in the media, the Department of Education and Health have put in place new, strict guidelines around students who are unwell. Please see the excerpt from the note, below;

School attendance Students should be at school unless:

- they have a medical certificate which states that they are unable to return to school due to an ongoing medical condition and the expected timeframe.
- they are currently unwell.

In accordance with advice from NSW Health, parents and carers are reminded NOT to send children to school if they are unwell, even if they have the mildest flu-like symptoms. Schools will make arrangements for students who present as unwell or have flu like symptoms to be sent home.

NSW Health have requested that schools encourage anyone who is unwell or has even mild flu-like symptoms, to arrange to be tested through their local medical practitioner or one of the COVID-19 clinics.

Students and staff with flu like symptoms will need to provide a copy of a negative COVID-19 test result before being permitted to return to school.

Kindergarten 2021

If you have a child starting Kindergarten next year, or you know of a family who has a child that is ready to start school, please ensure the school knows to hold a place for them! We are accepting both paper enrolments and online enrolments.

Communication with school

During these challenging times, we understand that communication with the school can be more difficult because parents and carers cannot be physically on the premises. My teachers are eager to relay information to you about your child and their learning. We are now using our school Facebook site to display the celebrations of work and learning for our students. If you do not follow us on Facebook, please do so. If at any time you wish to speak to your child's teacher, please contact the school and leave a brief message with the front office, regarding the reason for your call. My teachers will get back to you as soon as possible.

What happens if Balgownie PS needs to temporarily close? - We are trialling **Class Dojo** for communication from the class teacher, with their

class. This is a part of the preparations, for when/if the school is temporarily closed and we need to ensure your child has access to learning activities at home. We appreciate that not every family has ready access to online learning capacity or Google Classrooms. Therefore these activities will not necessarily be technology based. The class teacher will send home further information on Monday 24th August.
